

The Top 100 Strips In Full







Percentages of the top 100 are of the number of voters to select that strip as a favourite and apply to all unmarked strips beneath that figure until a new percentage is revealed, i.e. 5^{th} , $6^{th} \& 7^{th}$ picked up 43.5% of votes. Percentages of the Buster strips are of total votes cast, as voters could only select one title strip as their favourite. Strips with the same number of votes were positioned firstly according to length of original run in Buster, with longest strips coming first. In one case this was broken down further so a Buster originated strip came above reprints from another comic. All votes were cast between 29^{th} March & 21^{st} May 2009. Poll was run by <u>www.bustercomic.co.uk</u> – the premier Buster Fansite on the Internet and is in no way affiliated with Egmont UK. Results are passed to Egmont as a guide only and will not necessarily represent the final compilation of the Buster special.
